Professional Practice:

Patricia Hurl is an artist whose work spans the disciplines of painting, multi-media and collaborative art practice. Patricia was a lecturer in Fine Art in the DIT for 18 years, where she established a number of community –based programmes, in particular a Women’s Art Studies, aimed at women from the community around Portland Row, North Inner City, Dublin, and a ‘Gender Studies Through the Medium of Art (1997- ‘05’).

Her work has been regularly in selected shows and she has represented Ireland in Symposiums and residencies, in Atlanta ‘International Women’s Project 2000’, Caversham, S. Africa and Atlanta, USA. ‘The Artist’s Museum’, Zarragosa, Spain 2007.

She was a member of Temple Bar Gallery and Studios from 1986 – ‘09, when she moved to Co. Tipperary to live and set up a new studio space. Patricia has shown work in Ireland, UK, U.S.A .South Africa, Iceland and Spain. For the past twenty years she has worked with the artist Therry Rudin, which developed into video – performance projects, which has subsequently become an ongoing major part of their combined practice.

In 1913 they set up an artist-run contemporary Art Gallery in Damer House, which is part of Roscrea Heritage Centre. The Gallery has been running a wide program of exhibitions by established and emerging Irish and International Artists, including a very successful Short Film Programme ‘Homeland’ to promote new work . In 2017 were were invited to participate in ‘Loop’, the renowned annual International Film Festival in Barcelona, with great success resulting in an-ongoing collaboration, bringing state-of-the-art Film and Video Art to Roscrea.
